

Watermark Wesleyan Children's Re-Opening Policy

Watermark Wesleyan cannot guarantee that social distancing will be maintained throughout the entire time a child is at church, so we are taking extra precautionary measures for their safety and the safety of our staff and volunteers. Please understand this policy may be subject to change at any point in time.

Watermark Wesleyan Weekend Ministries will follow these guidelines:

- Children age 3 and older must always wear a mask when in the building, including classrooms.
- Each room will have a limited number of children allowed. If a room is full your child will have to attend the Worship Center with you.
- Social Distancing must be maintained while in the building, respecting a 6 feet distance during check-in, drop-off and pick-up and as families arrive and enter the building.
- Drop off & Pick-up limited to 1 parent per family. Parents will wait while the Children's Ministry room leader retrieves their child and then family will promptly exit the building.
- If a child is showing or experiencing any of the following symptoms, (temperatures at or over 100, cough, sore throat, runny nose, chills) parents will be instructed to take their child and leave the building.
- Children will be asked to use hand sanitizer immediately upon entering their room and exiting the restroom, even if hands were washed
- No food will be served or allowed in any of our children's rooms.
- No outside toys are allowed from home in the children's room.
- No outside cups/bottles will be allowed in the children's rooms.
- Room leaders will be doing appropriate cleaning and sanitizing as needed.
