

## Sermon Discussion Guide

### **Unstoppable – Week 1**

### **Moved by the Spirit**

**April 11, 2021**



### **Big Idea**

The church is unstoppable because it is unified and empowered by the Holy Spirit.



### **Icebreaker**

What's the biggest natural phenomenon you've ever experienced (storm, earthquake, tornado, etc.)?



### **Discussion Questions**

1. We have been challenged to read 28 chapters of Acts across 28 days. Using the SOAP (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer) method, everyone will have seven different observations each week. What is one of your observations from this week?
2. Read **Genesis 11:5-9**. Then read **Acts 2:5-6**. God went from scattering people to uniting them. What is the significance of the Jews speaking in the same language considering the events at the Tower of Babel? What does this reveal about God's view of unity in the church?
3. Read **Acts 2:14**. Peter went from denying Christ in smaller crowds to preaching his Gospel in front of thousands. How did Peter's brokenness contribute to his testimony? Can you relate to the progression of Peter's story from the Gospels to the book of Acts?
4. Read **Acts 1:8**. The Holy Spirit empowers us to do His kingdom work. What has the Holy Spirit empowered you to do that you wouldn't have been able to otherwise?
5. Read **Acts 2:38-41**. We are called to repent and be baptized. Have you been baptized? If so, what was that experience like? If not, do you think God might be leading you to it?



### **Concluding Questions**

Read Acts **2:42-45**. How is having the Holy Spirit "in common" with other believers encouraging to you? What do your community relationships look like? How can you serve others who need help?



### **Application**

1. What do you think the Holy Spirit may be saying to you through this sermon and our discussion?
2. What is something God wants you to do now?
3. Beyond prayer for each other, is there a way we can help each other apply what God is showing us?
