### **Heart Check: Press On**

### **Week 4: God's Generosity**

**Ephesians 3:6, 14-21 | October 25, 2020**

#### **Big Idea**

God is generous to us in many ways, so we should be generous to others in return.

#### **Opening Questions**

Think of a time someone was generous toward you. What happened? How did it make you feel? How do you think you would feel if you showed that kind of generosity?

#### **Key Scripture Questions**

1. Why is it important to check the health of our spiritual heart?
2. Read **Ephesians 3:6**. The Gospel is for all people. How could keeping this truth in mind potentially change your attitude of others? How could it change the church's attitude?
3. Read **Ephesians 3:14-17a**. Christ dwells in the believer's heart. How has your heart changed since you accepted Christ? What are some ways to keep that relationship thriving?
4. Read **Ephesians 3:17b-19**. God's love is immeasurable. Share about a time you felt filled with God's love. What things can get in the way of us feeling His love?
5. Read **Ephesians 3:20-21**. God exceeds our dreams. How have you seen God answer prayers in your life? Did His plan look different than what you dreamed of? If so, was that a good or bad thing for you?

#### **Concluding Questions**

How do the above truths reflect God's generosity? What is a practical way you can show generosity to someone else this week?

#### **Application Questions**

1. What do you think the Holy Spirit may be saying to you through this sermon and our discussion?
2. What is something God wants you to do now?
3. Beyond prayer for each other, is there a way we can help each other apply what God is showing us?
